# 2Q Spending Summary

Reconciliation of the total invoices forwarded to the Recipient (DHH) for processing through September 30, 2024, indicated twelve percent (12%/\$1,406,120) underspending of our total overall award (includes MAI funds).

The Recipient is working closely with Subrecipients to ensure timely submission of monthly invoices. Nevertheless, qualitative inferences (overspending/underspending) is premature. Spending trends are clearer the second half of the contract period.
