- **PHLConnectED** 
 - Connects eligible K–12 student households with access to reliable Internet service at no cost through June 2022
 - Participants will not pay any out-of-pocket expenses or installation fees. The program will also provide digital skills training and support
- **Internet Essentials from Comcast** 
 - Internet Essentials from Comcast brings affordable, high-speed Internet to your home so you can have greater access to homework, job opportunities, healthcare and benefits, education resources and more
- **The NerdiT Foundation** 
 - Donates technology in the Philadelphia area (and now internationally)

 - Provides basic computer classes
- **Philly’s Digital Navigator Program** 
 - Access, apply, and set up affordable and low-cost internet
 - Obtain low-cost or free computers
 - Get basic technical support
 - Troubleshoot connectivity issues
 - Refer individuals to digital literacy training
