THE HOMELESS SYSTEM

- The homeless system in Philadelphia consists of a Coordinated Entry process called CEA-BHRS
- Anyone who is homeless must enter this system through an intake process at one of our intake centers (Appletree Family Center or Roosevelt Darby)
- Matches could be to a program that offers a one-bedroom unit or a single room occupancy location.
- Each program is specific and eligibility to a provider is based on the VI-SPDAT assessment score.



FUNDING FOR HOUSING

CoC Funding: Provided by HUD and funds Rapid Re-Housing and Supportive Housing
\$37,000,000

HOPWA Funding through DHCD and the HOPWA list is managed by the Office of Homeless Services \$32,000,000

Emergency Solutions Grant (ESG): Provided through the State \$3,700,000

Youth Homelessness Demonstration Project (YHDP): \$8,900,000
