The infographic through US Census Bureau data provides an overview of the landscape and characteristics of the general population within the nine county Philadelphia Eligible Metropolitan Area (EMA) that includes: population size, average household size, poverty rates, unemployment, internet access, insurance status, educational attainment, and transportation needs. The nine counties are: Bucks, Chester, Delaware, Montgomery, Philadelphia, Burlington, Camden, Gloucester, and Salem.

Philadelphia EMA Poverty Profile
